In last three years, with 60 Surface Observatories, 10 Pilot Balloon Observatories, 4 Rawin Sonde Observatories, 19 Agrometeorological Observatories, 5 Radar and 2 Satellite Receiving ground stations, it has been providing forecasts and warnings for dealing with natural disasters such as sea cyclones, tidal surge, low pressure, heavy rainfall, floods, droughts, nor'wester, tornadoes, cold currents, heat waves, along with identifying the trend of climate change by monitoring and analyzing weather data of 24 hours.

#### 6.4 Bangladesh Air Force

**6.4.1 Recent Achievements:** As part of air defense, Bangladesh Air Force has successfully completed a total of 74,069:45 flying hours in the last three fiscal years through training and airspace patrolling of various categories of pilots. Air defense radars observed the skies of Bangladesh for 69,985:38 hours during this period. #### 6.6 Department of Meteorology

6.6.1 Recent Achievements: In the last three financial years, GEO-KOMSAT-2A Receiving and Analysis System, GIS Software and high-capacity computers have been purchased and installed at Storm Warning Center Dhaka. Calibration Lab, 1st class meteorological observatories at 14 river ports of the country, automatic weather stations, agricultural meteorological stations and automatic rain gauges have been installed at 225 locations in the country. A memorandum of understanding has been signed with Dhaka University and Khulna University and the Climate Change and Health Promotion Unit (CCHPU) of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare with Bangladesh Meteorological Department for the development and application of meteorological science. With the help of RIMES, arrangements have been made to automatically prepare spatial and 7-day agro-meteorological forecasting and advisory services in 211 upazilas of 17 districts. Automatic completion of agricultural weather forecasting and advisory service bulletins has been arranged. All meteorological offices in the country have been brought under internet connectivity.

## 6.7 Space Research and Remote Sensing Organization (SPARSO)

6.7.1 Recent Achievements: An FY-2 satellite data receiving station has been set up at SPARSSO to assist in disaster risk reduction. Besides, (a) Information is regularly sent to the Ministry of Agriculture, the Ministry of Food and the Department of Statistics and Information Management to determine the amount of cultivated area for the purpose of food security planning. (b) Information on flood-affected areas, population, houses and infrastructure and crop damage is sent to concerned ministries and agencies. (c) Morphological information of rivers is being updated regularly as per the instructions of the High Court. Besides, CS and RS map-based demarcation of the Buriganga river has been provided using GIS and RS technology as per the demand of the National River Protection Commission. (d) Monitoring the changes in different mangrove areas, reserved forest areas and other forest areas and providing the results to the relevant ministries and agencies. (e) Maps of tidal mud flats of sub-tidal areas across the country have been prepared using recent satellite images which can be used for land reclamation, afforestation and navigation purposes in sub-tidal areas.
